

COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

November 9, 2021

The Roberts County Commissioners met in regular session with Don Carlson, Dennis Jensen, Faye Johnston, Tom Vergeldt and Tim Zempel present. Chairman Jensen presiding. Jason Deutsch-Sisseton Courier livestream.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Carlson, seconded by Johnston to approve the agenda as presented and the November 2, 2021 minutes. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Jensen called for public comment. Jim Heyn and Valeri Burk-Aflac representatives met with Commissioners and discussed 2022 insurance renewals. Aflac will be meeting with county employees individually today and Wednesday.

STATES ATTORNEY

Dylan Kirchmeier met with Commissioners.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Motion by Zempel, seconded by Vergeldt to convene into Executive Session at 9:25 to discuss personnel pursuant to SDCL 1-25-2(1). Motion carried. Jensen declared meeting back into regular session at 9:47.

LANDFILL

Randy Deutsch met with Commissioners and submitted receivables.

Deutsch discussed issues with cells at the landfill and what is being done to get the issues remedied.

Deutsch discussed an estimate he received for a 2007 Rex TC-400 Landfill Compactor.

HIGHWAY

Pat Stickland met with Commissioners. Stickland submitted an estimate for bridge repair on County Road #15 and will work with Sheriff Appel to charge insurance of driver who hit the bridge.

Stickland discussed he and Tammy Johnson are working on small structure inventory for townships as part of Rural Access Infrastructure Funding.

TRANSFERS

Motion by Zempel, seconded by Johnston to transfer \$487.45 expenditure from Highway Budget to Landfill Budget which is an additional amount from transfer of \$7,111.20 in October 26, 2021 minutes (also error correction of transfer of ownership of scraper instead of loader as previously stated). Motion carried.

Motion by Carlson, seconded by Vergeldt to transfer \$240,552.19 from Highway Special Bridge Cash to Highway Cash Fund and supplement Highway Budget-Special Bridge Fund for \$938,581.90 all due to reimbursement from SD DOT Special Bridge Fund. Motion carried.
