

The Roberts County Commissioners met at 9:00 am in regular session with Brian Heinecke, John Dabek, Faye Johnston, Joe Fritz, Ken Nelson, Dylan Kirchmeier and Kristi Fritz in attendance. Jason Deutsch-Sisseton Courier livestream and Darin Fonder also in attendance. Chairman Heinecke presiding. Heinecke called the meeting to order and led the pledge of allegiance.

MINUTES/AGENDA

Motion by F Johnston, seconded by K Nelson to approve August 18, 2026, minutes and August 25, 2026, agenda as written. All voted aye, motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Darin Fonder met with the Board to discuss conditions of Eastman Rd and the Big Stone South-Hankinson-Bison (BSS-H-B) transmission line. Fonder was wondering if the County had an ordinance in place regarding setbacks.

STATES ATTORNEY

Dylan Kirchmeier-States Attorney mentioned there is an upcoming jury trial at the end of the week.

PUBLIC DEFENDER BID OPENING

Bids for the 2027 Public Defender contract as follows: Cameron Law \$185,000 (50% of services); Austin, Strait, Benson, Thole & Koehn LLP \$185,000 (50% of services). Both bids stated previous terms/conditions apply.

Motion by J Dabek, seconded by K Nelson to accept bids from Cameron Law and Austin, Strait, Benson, Thole & Koehn LLP for \$185,000 each with services being split 50/50 for the 2027 Public Defender contract effective Jan 1, 2027, through Dec 31, 2027. No discussion. All voted aye, motion carried.

Deputy Tyson Karsky and Deputy Jaylen Schulte introduced themselves to the Board.

Tyler Appel-Sheriff presented a prisoner count of 74. Appel had met with the Wilmot City Council to discuss a law enforcement contract for 15 hours/month at \$10,000/yr. The sheriff dept currently has contracts with Rosholt, New Effington and Summit towns.

They will be patching Eastman Rd. today, the bridge on Co Rd. 10 has been repaired and they plan to work on Co Rd 7.
